


Career Development Center Internship Offerings

Our Internship Programs

- Offer both for-credit and non-credit experiences
- Career Development Center can serve as single point of contact for information and posting positions
- Who oversees internships largely depends if it is a for-credit, or non-credit experience
 - For-Credit, oversight from academic department
 - Non-Credit, oversight from Career Development Center





Internship Highlights:

- 75% of our students do some sort of Applied Learning required by their major
- 400+ internships per year
- Local, Regional, National, International sites.

Process for Developing an Internship

- Contact the Career Development Center's Applied Learning Specialist Mr. Morgan Pellerin
- Phone consultation regarding internship description, activities students would be engaged in, and supervision. Possible site visit.
- Once approved, the position is posted in our <u>online job board</u>, raise awareness with intended majors.

Process for Developing an Internship Cont'd

- On the internship posting, you determine how you want students to apply
- Interview candidates, select who you deem is best
- If you select one of our students, notify us.
- Complete either for-credit or non-credit statement of expectations.
- Complete final evaluations for students.

Paid vs. Unpaid

- Since the State of Vermont is a non-profit entity, and can have unpaid interns.
- Regularly post paid and unpaid internships
- To recruit top talent, recommend stipend or paying interns
- NYS Government internships typically pay students minimum wage
